SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

30 ILCS 805/9.2 new

Amends the State Mandates Act. Provides that on and after January 1, 2007, no school district is required to implement or continue complying with any service mandate, tax exemption mandate, or personnel mandate, unless the cost of implementing or continuing to comply with the mandate is wholly recovered by the school district from federal, State, or other external aid. This applies (i) regardless of when the mandate was imposed, (ii) regardless of whether the mandate was previously exempted from the State reimbursement requirements of the Act, and (iii) notwithstanding any other provision of the Act or any other law to the contrary.

AN ACT concerning mandates on schools.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The State Mandates Act is amended by adding 5 Section 9.2 as follows:

6 (30 ILCS 805/9.2 new)

7 Sec. 9.2. Unfunded mandates on school districts.

8 <u>(a) On and after January 1, 2007, no school district is</u> 9 required to implement or continue complying with any service 10 <u>mandate, tax exemption mandate, or personnel mandate, unless</u> 11 <u>the cost of implementing or continuing to comply with the</u> 12 <u>mandate is wholly recovered by the school district from</u> 13 <u>federal, State, or other external aid.</u>

14 (b) This Section applies (i) regardless of when the mandate 15 was imposed, (ii) regardless of whether the mandate was 16 previously exempted from the State reimbursement requirements 17 of this Act, and (iii) notwithstanding any other provision of 18 this Act or any other law to the contrary.
