## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Sec. 10-3-3.1. Distinct police and fire duties. A non-home
- 8 <u>rule municipality shall not assign a "fireman", as defined in</u>
- 9 <u>Section 10-3-2, to perform police duties or a "policeman", as</u>
- defined in Section 10-3-1, to perform firefighting duties or in
- 11 any way combine the duties of a fireman or a policeman after
- 12 his or her appointment from a police department or fire
- department register of eligibles. A non-home rule municipality
- 14 <u>shall not administer its fire department's or police</u>
- department's regular work assignments in a manner inconsistent
- 16 with this Section. This Section does not apply to any
- 17 <u>municipality that created a department of public safety before</u>
- 18 <u>January 1, 1998.</u>
- 19 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- 20 becoming law.
