## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

210 ILCS 45/3-610

from Ch. 111 1/2, par. 4153-610

Amends the Nursing Home Care Act. Provides that a nursing home employee or agent who becomes aware of another employee or agent's theft or misappropriation of a resident's property must immediately report the matter to the facility administrator. Provides that a facility administrator who becomes aware of a nursing home employee or agent's theft or misappropriation of a resident's property must immediately report the matter by telephone and in writing to the resident's representative, to the Department of Public Health, and to the local law enforcement agency. Prohibits retaliation against a nursing home employee or agent who reports the theft or misappropriation of a resident's property.

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AN ACT concerning regulation.

#### Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 2 represented in the General Assembly: 3

Section 5. The Nursing Home Care Act is amended by changing 4 5 Section 3-610 as follows:

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(210 ILCS 45/3-610) (from Ch. 111 1/2, par. 4153-610) Sec. 3-610. Duty to report violations.

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(a) A facility employee or agent who becomes aware of abuse 8 or neglect of a resident prohibited by Section 2-107 shall 9 immediately report the matter to the Department and to the 10 facility administrator. A facility administrator who becomes 11 aware of abuse or neglect of a resident prohibited by Section 12 2-107 shall immediately report the matter by telephone and in 13 14 writing to the resident's representative, and to the

Department. Any person may report a violation of Section 2-107

to the Department. 17 (b) A facility employee or agent who becomes aware of another facility employee or agent's theft or misappropriation 18 19 of a resident's property must immediately report the matter to the facility administrator. A facility administrator who 20 21 becomes aware of a facility employee or agent's theft or misappropriation of a resident's property must immediately 22 report the matter by telephone and in writing to the resident's 23 representative, to the Department, and to the local law 24 enforcement agency. Neither a licensee nor its employees or 25 26 agents may dismiss or otherwise retaliate against a facility employee or agent who reports the theft or misappropriation of 27 28 a resident's property under this subsection.
