1 AN ACT concerning criminal law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Unified Code of Corrections is amended by adding Section 3-4-3.1 as follows:

- 7 <u>Sec. 3-4-3.1. Identification documents of committed</u>
- 8 persons.
- 9 (a) Driver's licenses, State issued identification cards,
- 10 <u>social security account cards</u>, or other government issued
- 11 <u>identification documents in possession of a county sheriff at</u>
- 12 <u>the time a person is committed to the Illinois Department of</u>
- Corrections shall be forwarded to the Department.
- 14 (b) The Department shall retain the government issued
- 15 <u>identification documents of a committed person at the</u>
- 16 <u>institution in which the person is incarcerated and shall</u>
- 17 <u>ensure that the documents are forwarded to any institution to</u>
- which the person is transferred.
- 19 (c) The government issued identification documents of a
- 20 committed person shall be made available to the person upon
- 21 <u>discharge from the Department.</u>
