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AN ACT concerning veterans.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Department of Veterans Affairs Act is 5 amended by changing Section 2.07 as follows:

6 (20 ILCS 2805/2.07) (from Ch. 126 1/2, par. 67.07)

7 Sec. 2.07. The Department shall employ and maintain sufficient and qualified staff at the veterans' homes to 8 fulfill the requirements of this Act. The Department shall 9 10 report to the General Assembly, by January 1 and July 1 of each year, the number of staff employed in providing direct patient 11 care at their veterans' homes, the compliance or noncompliance 12 with staffing standards established by the United States 13 14 Department of Veterans Affairs for such care, and in the event 15 of noncompliance with such standards, the number of staff 16 required for compliance. For purposes of this Section, a nurse 17 who has a license application pending with the State shall not be deemed unqualified by the Department if the nurse is in 18 compliance with 225 ILCS 65/5-15(g) or 225 ILCS 5-15(i) of the 19 20 Nursing and Advanced Practice Nursing Act.

All contracts between the State and outside contractors to 21 22 provide workers to staff and service the Anna Veterans Home shall be canceled in accordance with the terms of those 23 contracts. Upon cancellation, each worker or staff member shall 24 25 be offered certified employment status under the Illinois Personnel Code with the State of Illinois. To the extent it is 26 reasonably practicable, the position offered to each person 27 28 shall be at the same facility and shall consist of the same 29 duties and hours as previously existed under the canceled 30 contract or contracts.
