Amends the Illinois Insurance Code. Makes a technical change in a Section concerning the use of DES.

1 AN ACT concerning regulation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Insurance Code is amended by changing Section 356f as follows:
- 6 (215 ILCS 5/356f) (from Ch. 73, par. 968f)
- 7 Sec. 356f. No policy of accident or health insurance or any
- 8 renewal thereof shall be denied or cancelled by $\underline{\text{the}}$
- 9 insurer, nor shall any such policy contain any exception or
- 10 exclusion of benefits, solely because the mother of the insured
- 11 has taken diethylstilbestrol, commonly referred to as DES.
