11	each in a separate location, at times and places determined by	
12	the board. The time of place of each hearing must be chosen to	
13	ensure maximum participation within the school's local	
14	attendance area.	
15	If a preponderance of the t	testimony at the hearings is in
16	opposition to the closure, the board and any parties opposing	
17	the closure must submit to federal mediation. A mediator from	
18	the National Mediation Board sl	hall be appointed to work with
19	the board and the opposing parties to determine whether the	
20	school should be closed.	
21	If there is no resolution w	vithin 60 days after submitting
22	to mediation, the board may no	ot close the school until the
23	question of closing the school	ol has been submitted to the
24	electors of the school's local	. attendance area at a regular
