1 AN ACT concerning business.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The Consumer Fraud and Deceptive Business
- 5 Practices Act is amended by changing Section 11 as follows:
- 6 (815 ILCS 505/11) (from Ch. 121 1/2, par. 271)
- 7 Sec. 11. If any provision of this Act or $\underline{\text{the}}$
- 8 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held
- 9 invalid, the invalidity shall not affect other provisions or
- 10 applications of the Act which can be given effect without the
- invalid provision or application and to this end the provisions
- of this Act are severable.
