Amends the Employee Benefit Contribution Act. Makes a technical change in a Section concerning the failure to make payments to an employee health insurance plan.

1 AN ACT concerning employment.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Employee Benefit Contribution Act is amended by changing Section 2 as follows:
- 6 (820 ILCS 160/2) (from Ch. 48, par. 39x)
- 7 Sec. 2. Any employer who has agreed to make payments to an employee health insurance plan shall notify its employees of 8 9 any failure to make such payments where such failure shall result in the the total loss of insurance coverage so as to 10 11 provide its employees a reasonable opportunity to replace such 12 coverage at the time the employee health insurance plan terminates. The employer must provide written notification 13 14 directly to each of its employees who are covered under the plan. Any employer who fails to provide timely notice of a 15 prospective termination of a health insurance plan, which 16 17 failure results in the deprivation of the opportunity to replace such coverage and which further results in damages to 18 19 one or more employees arising from the loss of coverage, shall 20 be quilty of a Class B misdemeanor.
