Amend House Bill 2137 by replacing 3 lines 28 through 30 on page 1 and lines 1 through 3 on page 2 with the period the following: 4 5 "and any other information required by the Department. Statements shall be filed with the Department by a contractor 6 at the beginning of each calendar year for independent contractors performing work for the contractor at the beginning of that calendar year. A contractor shall file statements with the Department on April 1, July 1, and October 1 for any 10 additional independent contractors who began performing work 11 for the contractor during the 3-month period immediately 12 preceding the filing date. Contractors may file statements by 13 e-mail. The information obtained by"; and 14 15 on page 3, line 28 by inserting after the period the following: 16 "Any action by the Department directing a contractor to cease 17 its operations on a project may not take effect until the contractor's administrative remedies have been exhausted."; 18 19 and on page 3, line 33 by changing "Class 4 felony" to "Class A 20 21 misdemeanor".
