AN ACT concerning education.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Southern Illinois University Management Act
is amended by adding Section 8i as follows:

(110 ILCS 520/8i new) 6 7 Sec. 8i. Vince Demuzio Governmental Internship Program. 8 (a) The president of the University, in consultation with the Board, shall establish a governmental internship program 9 consisting of up to 30 governmental interns allocated between 10 the Carbondale and Edwardsville campuses. 11 (b) In order to be eligible under the program, a person 12 must be enrolled as a full-time undergraduate student during 13 14 the entirety of his or her participation in the program. 15 (c) The following shall be the goals of the program: (1) To attract highly motivated students into the 16 17 program. 18 (2) To provide students with a broad overview of State 19 government. (3) To offer students a unique hands-on experience. 20 21 (4) To provide students with a personal look into the budgetary, legislative, and programmatic areas of State 22 23 government. (5) To provide students with a unique opportunity to 24 25 learn about and to advance into public service careers, 26 including policy-making positions in government. (6) To offer a governmental experience to meet the 27 public sector's future need for competent administrators. 28 (7) To provide a public sector internship that 29 30 encourages talented college graduates to consider careers in State government. 31 32 (8) To enable college graduates to supplement their

(d) All students participating in the program shall receive 8 9 academic credit as determined by the University. Students shall also be compensated financially as determined by the 10 University. The program shall not include a waiver of tuition 11 12 or fees. 13 (e) The program is subject to specific annual appropriation by the General Assembly. 14

Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon becoming law.
