Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 2 represented in the General Assembly: 3

- Section 5. The Board of Higher Education Act is amended by 4 5 adding Section 9.30 as follows:
- (110 ILCS 205/9.30 new) 6
- 7 Sec. 9.30. Course transferability program.
- (a) Subject to appropriation, the Board shall implement and 8 administer a statewide program, using the World Wide Web, to 9 assist students, advisors, faculty, and administrators from 10 public and private institutions of higher education in 11 obtaining consistent and accurate information about transfer 12 courses and their applicability towards degree completion by 13 publishing course equivalency quides, academic programs, 14 15 courses offered, transfer course evaluations, and degree
- 16 requirements.

- 17 (b) Under the program, the Board shall provide appropriate assistance and support to participating public and private 18 19 institutions of higher education. The Board shall designate participants based on which institutions apply to be part of 20 the program. However, all data shall be managed by each 21 institution of higher education and each institution shall 22 retain complete ownership of the data submitted.
- (c) The program's Internet website shall contain the 24 25 following:
- 26 (1) Transfer course articulations, which shall be updated annually. 27
- 28 (2) Institutional reference tables.
- (3) Degree requirements, which shall be updated 29 30 annually.
- (4) Course banks, which shall be updated annually. 31
- 32 (5) Academic program pull down menus, which shall be
