2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Department of Natural Resources
(Conservation) Law of the Civil Administrative Code of Illinois
is amended by changing Section 805-305 as follows:

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(20 ILCS 805/805-305) (was 20 ILCS 805/63a23)

805-305. Campsites and housing facilities. 8 Sec. The Department has the power to provide facilities for overnight 9 tent and trailer camp sites and to provide suitable housing 10 facilities for student and juvenile overnight camping groups. 11 of Natural Resources 12 The Department may regulate, by administrative order, the fees to be charged for tent and 13 14 trailer camping units at individual park areas based upon the 15 facilities available. However, for campsites with access to showers or electricity, any Illinois resident who is age 62 or 16 17 older or has a Class 2 disability as defined in Section 4A of the Illinois Identification Card Act shall be charged only 18 19 one-half of the camping fee charged to the general public during the period Monday through Thursday of any week and shall 20 be charged the same camping fee as the general public on all 21 22 other days. For campsites without access to showers or electricity, no camping fee authorized by this Section shall be 23 charged to any resident of Illinois who has a Class 2 24 25 disability as defined in Section 4A of the Illinois 26 Identification Card Act. For campsites without access to showers or electricity, no camping fee authorized by this 27 28 Section shall be charged to any resident of Illinois who is age 29 62 or older for the use of a camp site unit during the period 30 Monday through Thursday of any week. No camping fee authorized by this Section shall be charged to any resident of Illinois 31 32 who is a disabled veteran or a former prisoner of war, as

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1 defined in Section 5 of the Department of Veterans Affairs Act. 2 No camping fee authorized by this Section shall be charged to any resident of Illinois after returning from service abroad or 3 mobilization by the President of the United States as an active 4 5 duty member of the United States Armed Forces, the Illinois National Guard, or the Reserves of the United States Armed 6 Forces for the amount of time that the active duty member spent 7 in service abroad or mobilized if the person applies for a pass 8 at the Department office in Springfield within 2 years of 9 returning and provides verification of service or mobilization 10 11 to the Department; any portion of a year that the active duty member spent in service abroad or mobilized shall count as a 12 full year. Nonresidents shall be charged the same fees as are 13 authorized for the general public regardless of age. The 14 15 Department shall provide by regulation for suitable proof of 16 age, or either a valid driver's license or a "Golden Age 17 Passport" issued by the federal government shall be acceptable as proof of age. The Department shall further provide by 18 19 regulation that notice of these reduced admission fees be 20 posted in a conspicuous place and manner.

21 Reduced fees authorized in this Section shall not apply to 22 any charge for utility service.

29 (a) After returning from service abroad or mobilization by 30 the President of the United States as an active duty member of 31 the United States Armed Forces, the Illinois National Guard, or 32 the Reserves of the United States Armed Forces, an Illinois 33 resident may fish as permitted by this Code without paying any 34 fees required to obtain a fishing license for the time period HB2550 Enrolled - 3 - LRB094 10416 LJB 40686 b

prescribed by subsection (b) of this Section if the Illinois resident applies for a license within 2 years of returning from service abroad or mobilization. The applicant shall provide verification of service or mobilization to the Department at the Department's office in Springfield.

6 <u>(b) For each year that an applicant is an active duty</u> 7 <u>member pursuant to subsection (a) of this Section, the</u> 8 <u>applicant shall receive one free fishing license. For the</u> 9 <u>purposes of this determination, if the period of active duty is</u> 10 <u>a portion of a year (for example, one year and 3 months), the</u> 11 <u>applicant will be credited with a full year for the portion of</u> 12 a <u>year served.</u>

13 (c) The Department shall establish what constitutes
14 suitable verification of service or mobilization under
15 subsection (a) of this Section.

- Section 15. The Wildlife Code is amended by adding Section 3.1-4 as follows:
- 18 (520 ILCS 5/3.1-4 new)

19 <u>Sec. 3.1-4. Military members returning from mobilization</u> 20 and service outside the United States.

(a) After returning from service abroad or mobilization by 21 the President of the United States as an active duty member of 22 the United States Armed Forces, the Illinois National Guard, or 23 the Reserves of the United States Armed Forces, an Illinois 24 25 resident may hunt any of the species protected by Section 2.2 of this Code without paying any fees required to obtain a 26 hunting license for the time period prescribed by subsection 27 (b) of this Section if the Illinois resident applies for a 28 29 license within 2 years of returning from service abroad or mobilization. The applicant shall provide verification of 30 31 service or mobilization to the Department at the Department's office in Springfield. 32 (b) For each year that an applicant is an active duty 33

34 member pursuant to subsection (a) of this Section, the

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applicant shall receive one free hunting license, one free Deer 1 2 Hunting Permit as provided in Section 2.26 of this Code and 3 rules adopted pursuant to that Section, and one free State Habitat Stamp. For the purposes of this determination, if the 4 period of active duty is a portion of a year (for example, one 5 year and 3 months), the applicant will be credited with a full 6 7 year for the portion of a year served. (c) The Department shall establish what constitutes 8 suitable verification of service or mobilization under 9

10 <u>subsection (a) of this Section.</u>
