16 Section 10. The sum of \$37,579,300, or so much thereof 17 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Criminal 18 Justice Trust Fund to the Illinois Criminal Justice 19 Information Authority for awards and grants to local units of 20 government and non-profit organizations.

21 Section 15. The sum of \$12,100,000, or so much thereof 22 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Criminal 23 Justice Trust Fund to the Illinois Criminal Justice 24 Information Authority for awards and grants to state 25 agencies.

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Section 25. The following named amounts, or so much 4 5 thereof as may be necessary, are appropriated to the Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority for awards and grants 6 and other monies received from federal agencies, from other 7 units of government, and from private/not-for-profit 8 organizations for activities undertaken in support 9 of 10 investigating issues in criminal justice and for undertaking other criminal justice information projects: 11 Payable from the Criminal Justice 12 Trust Fund ..... 1,700,000 13 Payable from the Criminal Justice 14 15 \$2,200,000 16 Total

17 Section 30. The following named amounts, or so much 18 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects 19 and purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated to the 20 Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority for awards, 21 grants and operational support to implement the Motor Vehicle 22 Theft Prevention Act:

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5 Section 35. The sum of \$40,000,000, or so much thereof 6 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Criminal 7 Justice Trust Fund to the Illinois Criminal Justice 8 Information Authority for awards and grants to state agencies 9 and units of local government, to include operational 10 activities and programs undertaken by the Authority, in 11 support of Federal Crime Bill Initiatives.

12 Section 40. The sum of \$12,540,000, or so much thereof 13 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Juvenile 14 Accountability Incentive Block Grant Trust Fund to the 15 Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority for awards 16 and grants to state agencies and units of local government, 17 including operational expenses of the Authority in support of 18 the Juvenile Accountability Incentive Block Grant program.

Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,20 2005.
