AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 2890

AMENDMENT NO. $\qquad$ . Amend House Bill 2890 by replacing everything after the enacting clause with the following:
"Section 1. Short title. This Act may be cited as the Social Security Number Nondisclosure Act.

Section 5. Definition. In this Act, "State agency" means and includes all of the following:
(1) All officers, boards, commissions, courts, and agencies created by the Illinois Constitution, whether in the executive, legislative, or judicial branch.
(2) All officers, departments, boards, commissions, agencies, institutions, authorities, universities, and bodies politic and corporate of the State.
(3) All administrative units or corporate outgrowths of the State government that are created by or pursuant to statute, other than units of local government and their officers, school districts, and boards of election commissioners.
(4) All administrative units and corporate outgrowths of any entity described in paragraphs (1) through (3) and as may be created by executive order of the Governor.

Section 10. Disclosure of social security number prohibited. Unless otherwise expressly authorized by law, a

State agency may not disclose or require disclosure of an individual's social security number in any way, including by means of any of the following:
(1) By printing or otherwise disclosing the individual's social security number on a check issued to or on behalf of the individual.
(2) By printing or otherwise disclosing the individual's social security number in any correspondence addressed to the individual or concerning the individual.
(3) By requiring the individual or another person on the individual's behalf to disclose the individual's social security number on any application or other form used by the State agency.

Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect January 1, 2006.".
