Sec. 16-165. Board; elected members; vacancies.

23 (a) In each odd-numbered year, there shall be elected 2 teachers who shall hold office for a term of 4 years beginning July 15 next following their election, in the manner provided under this Section. <u>An elected teacher member of the board who</u> <u>ceases to be a teacher as defined in Section 16-106 may</u> <u>continue to serve on the board for the remainder of the term to</u> <u>which he or she was elected.</u>

(b) One elected annuitant trustee shall first be elected in
1987, and in every fourth year thereafter, for a term of 4
years beginning July 15 next following his or her election.

10 (c) The elected annuitant position created by this 11 amendatory Act of the 91st General Assembly shall be filled as 12 soon as possible in the manner provided for vacancies, for an 13 initial term ending July 15, 2001. One elected annuitant 14 trustee shall be elected in 2001, and in every fourth year 15 thereafter, for a term of 4 years beginning July 15 next 16 following his or her election.

(d) Elections shall be held on May 1, unless May 1 falls on 17 18 a Saturday or Sunday, in which event the election shall be conducted on 19 the following Monday. Candidates shall be 20 nominated by petitions in writing, signed by not less than 500 21 teachers or annuitants, as the case may be, with their addresses shown opposite their names. The petitions shall be 22 23 filed with the board's Secretary not less than 90 nor more than 24 120 days prior to May 1. The Secretary shall determine their 25 validity not less than 75 days before the election.

26 (e) If, for either teacher or annuitant members, the number qualified nominees exceeds the number of available 27 of 28 positions, the system shall prepare an appropriate ballot with 29 the names of the candidates in alphabetical order and shall mail one copy thereof, at least 10 days prior to the election 30 31 day, to each teacher or annuitant of this system as of the latest date practicable, at the latest known address, together 32 33 with a return envelope addressed to the board and also a smaller envelope marked "For Ballot Only", and a slip for 34

signature. Each voter, upon marking his ballot with a cross 1 mark in the square before the name of the person voted for, 2 3 shall place the ballot in the envelope marked "For Ballot 4 Only", seal the envelope, write on the slip provided therefor 5 his signature and address, enclose both the slip and sealed envelope containing the marked ballot in the return envelope 6 7 addressed to the board, and mail it. Whether a person is 8 eligible to vote for the teacher nominees or the annuitant nominees shall be determined from system payroll records as of 9 10 March 1.

11 Upon receipt of the return envelopes, the system shall open them and set aside unopened the envelopes marked "For Ballot 12 13 Only". On election day ballots shall be publicly opened and counted by the trustees or canvassers appointed therefor. Each 14 15 vote cast for a candidate represents one vote only. No ballot arriving after 10 o'clock a.m. on election day shall be 16 counted. The 2 teacher candidates and the annuitant candidate 17 receiving the highest number of votes shall be elected. The 18 19 board shall declare the results of the election, keep a record 20 thereof, and notify the candidates of the results thereof 21 within 30 days after the election.

If, for either class of members, there are only as many qualified nominees as there are positions available, the balloting as described in this Section shall not be conducted for those nominees, and the board shall declare them duly elected.

(f) A vacancy occurring in the elective membership <u>of</u> on the board shall be filled for the unexpired term by the board with a person qualified for the vacant position<u>, selected by</u> <u>the remaining elected members of the board</u>.
