- 8 within the State a lottery to be operated by the State, the

- 11 Section 21.2 and 21.6.

- Sec. 20. <u>State Lottery Fund.</u>
- 15 <u>(a)</u> There is created in the State Treasury a special fund
- 16 to be known as the "State Lottery Fund". Such fund shall
- 17 consist of all revenues received from (1) the sale of lottery
- 18 tickets or shares, (net of commissions, fees representing those
- 19 expenses that are directly proportionate to the sale of tickets
- or shares at the agent location, and prizes of less than \$600
- 21 which have been validly paid at the agent level), (2)
- 22 application fees, and (3) all other sources including moneys
- 23 credited or transferred thereto from any other fund or source
- 24 pursuant to law. Interest earnings of the State Lottery Fund
- shall be credited to the Common School Fund.

- 30 Sec. 21.6. Scratch-off for Illinois veterans.

- 1 The Department shall offer a special instant
- 2 scratch-off game for the benefit of Illinois veterans. The game
- shall commence on January 1, 2006 or as soon thereafter, at the 3
- discretion of the Director, as is reasonably practical. The 4
- 5 operation of the game shall be governed by this Act and any
- rules adopted by the Department. If any provision of this 6
- Section is inconsistent with any other provision of this Act, 7
- then this Section governs. 8
- (b) The Illinois Veterans Assistance Fund is created as a 9
- special fund in the State treasury. The net revenue from the 10
- 11 Illinois veterans scratch-off game shall be deposited into the
- 12 Fund for appropriation by the General Assembly solely to the
- Department of Veterans Affairs for making grants, funding 13
- additional services, or conducting additional research 14
- 15 projects relating to:

- 29 Moneys received for the purposes of this Section,
- 30 including, without limitation, net revenue from the special

- For purposes of this subsection, "net revenue" means the 35
- total amount for which tickets have been sold less the sum of 36

- 2 <u>expenses of the Department solely related to the scratch-off</u>
- 3 game under this Section.
- 4 (c) During the time that tickets are sold for the Illinois
- 5 <u>veterans scratch-off game, the Department shall not</u>
- 6 <u>unreasonably diminish the efforts devoted to marketing any</u>
- 7 other instant scratch-off lottery game.
- 8 (d) The Department may adopt any rules necessary to
- 9 <u>implement and administer the provisions of this Section.</u>
