1 AN ACT concerning methamphetamine.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The Department of State Police Law of the Civil
- 5 Administrative Code of Illinois is amended by adding Section
- 6 2605-211 as follows:
- 7 (20 ILCS 2605/2605-211 new)
- 8 Sec. 2605-211. Protocol; methamphetamine; illegal
- 9 manufacture.
- 10 (a) The Department of State Police, the Environmental
- 11 Protection Agency, and the Department of Public Health shall
- 12 jointly develop a protocol to be followed in determining
- 13 whether a dwelling, structure, or other site at which
- 14 <u>methamphetamine had been illegally manufactured may again be</u>
- safely put to its intended legal use, including but not limited
- to standards for the removal of contaminants in and around the
- dwelling, structure, or other site, remediation of plumbing
- 18 <u>systems and ventilation systems</u>, and abatement of any other
- 19 <u>substantial danger to health and safety. If the contaminated</u>
- 20 <u>site is inside a dwelling or structure used as a dwelling, the</u>
- 21 <u>implementation of the protocol shall be the purview of the</u>
- 22 <u>Department of Public Health. If the contaminated site is</u>
- 23 <u>outdoors or in a structure not used as a dwelling, the protocol</u>
- 24 <u>shall be the purview of the Illinois Environmental Protection</u>
- 25 Agency.
- 26 (b) The Department of State Police, the Environmental
- 27 <u>Protection Agency</u>, and the Department of Public Health must
- develop the protocol by January 1, 2006.
- (c) The Department of State Police, the Environmental
- 30 Protection Agency, and the Department of Public Health must
- 31 each post the protocol on their official Web sites.

- Section 10. The Environmental Protection Act is amended by adding Section 22.50 as follows:
- 3 (415 ILCS 5/22.50 new)
- 4 Sec. 22.50. Protocol; methamphetamine; illegal
- 5 <u>manufacture</u>. The Environmental Protection Agency and the
- 6 Department of Public Health shall cooperate with the Department
- 7 <u>of State Police in developing the protocol required under</u>
- 8 Section 2605-211 of the Department of State Police Law of the
- 9 Civil Administrative Code of Illinois.
- 10 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- 11 becoming law.
