Amends the School Code. Allows a school board to require a student who participates in a school-sponsored or school-supported athletic or extra-curricular activity to submit to a drug test as a condition of participation. Effective immediately.

AN ACT concerning education.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The School Code is amended by changing Sections
10-22.10a and 34-18.12 as follows:

8 <u>(a)</u> School boards are empowered to adopt a policy to 9 authorize school officials to request the assistance of law 10 enforcement officials for the purpose of conducting reasonable 11 searches of school grounds and lockers for illegal drugs, 12 including searches conducted through the use of specially 13 trained dogs.

14 (b) A school board may require a student who participates 15 in a school-sponsored or school-supported athletic or 16 extra-curricular activity to submit to a drug test as a 17 condition of participation.

21 <u>(a)</u> The Board of Education is empowered to authorize school 22 officials to request the assistance of law enforcement 23 officials for the purpose of conducting reasonable searches of 24 school grounds and lockers for illegal drugs, including 25 searches conducted through the use of specially trained dogs.

26 (b) The Board of Education may require a student who 27 participates in a school-sponsored or school-supported 28 athletic or extra-curricular activity to submit to a drug test 29 as a condition of participation.
