# Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

3 Section 20. The sum of \$2,596,100, or so much thereof as 4 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue 5 Fund to the Board of Higher Education for a grant to the 6 Board of Trustees of the University Center of Lake County for 7 the ordinary and contingent expenses of the Center.

8 Section 25. The sum of \$4,750,000, or so much thereof as 9 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue 10 Fund to the Board of Higher Education for distribution as 11 incentive grants to Illinois higher education institutions in 12 the competition for external grants and contracts, as 13 authorized by the Board of Higher Education Act.

Section 40. The sum of \$5,500,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the BHE Federal Grants Fund to the Board of Higher Education to be expended under the terms and conditions associated with the federal contracts and grants moneys received.
