## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

5 ILCS 490/68 new

Amends the State Commemorative Dates Act. Designates September 1 of each year as American Indian Heritage Day to be observed throughout the State as a day to honor the rich history, culture, and heritage of American Indians.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The State Commemorative Dates Act is amended by adding Section 68 as follows:
- 6 (5 ILCS 490/68 new)
- Sec. 68. American Indian Heritage Day. September 1 of each
- 8 year is designated as American Indian Heritage Day to be
- 9 observed throughout the State as a day to honor the rich
- 10 history, culture, and heritage of American Indians.
