SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

Appropriates \$145,700 from the General Revenue Fund to the Department of Human Services for the purpose of providing a 3% cost-of-doing-business adjustment for Centers for Independent Living. Effective immediately.

BALANCED BUDGET NOTE ACT MAY APPLY 1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The sum of \$145,700, or so much of that amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Department of Human Services for the purpose of providing a 3% cost-of-doing-business adjustment for Centers for Independent Living to continue providing core independent living services and other Disability services in the State of Illinois.
- 11 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon becoming law.
