for any person age 60 or older who presents the Secretary of State's office with a police report showing that his license or permit was stolen.

2	motor vehicle in this State has been suspended or revoked under
3	Section 3-707, any provision of Chapter 6, Chapter 11, or
4	Section 7-205, 7-303, or 7-702 of the Family Financial
5	Responsibility Law of this Code, shall in addition to any other
6	fees required by this Code, pay a reinstatement fee as follows:
7	Suspension under Section 3-707 \$100
8	Summary suspension under Section 11-501.1 \$250
9	Other suspension \$70
10	Revocation \$500
11	However, any person whose license or privilege to operate a
12	motor vehicle in this State has been suspended or revoked for a
13	second or subsequent time for a violation of Section 11-501 or
14	11-501.1 of this Code or a similar provision of a local
15	ordinance or a similar out-of-state offense or Section 9-3 of
16	the Criminal Code of 1961 and each suspension or revocation was
17	for a violation of Section 11-501 or 11-501.1 of this Code or a

18 similar provision of a local ordinance or a similar 19 out-of-state offense or Section 9-3 of the Criminal Code of 20 1961 shall pay, in addition to any other fees required by this 21 Code, a reinstatement fee as follows:

1 (D) \$4 of the \$8 fee for a restricted driving 2 permit.

2. \$30 of the \$250 fee for reinstatement of a license 3 4 summarily suspended under Section 11-501.1 shall be 5 deposited into the Drunk and Drugged Driving Prevention Fund. However, for a person whose license or privilege to 6 7 operate a motor vehicle in this State has been suspended or 8 revoked for a second or subsequent time for a violation of Section 11-501 or 11-501.1 of this Code or Section 9-3 of 9 the Criminal Code of 1961, \$190 of the \$500 fee for 10 reinstatement of a license summarily suspended under 11 Section 11-501.1, and \$190 of the \$500 fee 12 for reinstatement of a revoked license shall be deposited into 13 the Drunk and Drugged Driving Prevention Fund. 14

3. \$6 of such original or renewal fee for a commercial driver's license and \$6 of the commercial driver instruction permit fee when such permit is issued to any person holding a valid Illinois driver's license, shall be paid into the CDLIS/AAMVAnet Trust Fund.

4. \$30 of the \$70 fee for reinstatement of a license
suspended under the Family Financial Responsibility Law
shall be paid into the Family Responsibility Fund.

5. The \$5 fee for each original or renewal M or L
endorsement shall be deposited into the Cycle Rider Safety
Training Fund.

6. \$20 of any original or renewal fee for a commercial
driver's license or commercial driver instruction permit
shall be paid into the Motor Carrier Safety Inspection
Fund.
