SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

20 ILCS 605/605-347 new

Amends the Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity Law of the Civil Administrative Code of Illinois. Requires the Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity to establish and maintain a program to certify energy-efficient appliances. Provides that, under the program, the Department must identify which appliances qualify as certified energy-efficient appliances and must identify the average first-year kilowatt hours saved, or the equivalent for other fuel saved, by the use of the appliance. Requires the Department to post this information in its Internet website. Effective immediately.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

to heat or cool a dwelling, or other major household appliance

- that, according to the standards set forth under the federal
- 17 Energy Guide, has premium energy-efficient characteristics.
- 18 (c) Under this program, the Department must identify which
- 19 appliances qualify as certified energy-efficient appliances
- and must identify the average first-year kilowatt hours saved,
- or the equivalent for other fuel saved, by the use of the
- 22 appliance.

- 23 (d) The Department must post, on its Internet website, a
- 24 <u>list of each certified energy-efficient appliance and the</u>
- 25 <u>average first-year kilowatt hours saved, or the equivalent for</u>
- other fuel saved, by the use of that appliance.
- 27 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- 28 becoming law.
