## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 2 represented in the General Assembly: 3

- Section 5. The Code of Civil Procedure is amended by 4 5 changing Section 1-106 as follows:
- (735 ILCS 5/1-106) (from Ch. 110, par. 1-106)
- 7 Sec. 1-106. Act to be liberally construed. This Act shall
- be liberally construed, to  $\underline{\text{the}}$  end that controversies may 8
- be speedily and finally determined according to the substantive 9
- rights of the parties. The rule that statutes in derogation of 10
- the common law must be strictly construed does not apply to 11
- this Act or to the rules made in relation thereto. 12
