#### SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

625 ILCS 5/3-712 new

Amends the Illinois Vehicle Code. Provides that any person who, for the purpose of obtaining or renewing a military special license plate, falsely and knowingly claims either to have been awarded a military decoration or to be on active duty in the United States Armed Forces or a military veteran is guilty of a Class A misdemeanor and shall, in addition to any other penalty, be fined not less than \$1,000.

# 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by adding
Section 3-712 as follows:

6 (625 ILCS 5/3-712 new)

7 Sec. 3-712. Fraudulent application for military special plates. Any person who, for the purpose of obtaining or 8 renewing a special license plate designating military 9 10 decorations, military service, or status as a military veteran, claims (i) to have been awarded a military decoration, knowing 11 that he or she has not been awarded that decoration, or (ii) to 12 be on active duty in the United States Armed Forces or a 13 military veteran, knowing that he or she does not have the 14 15 status required for the registration for which he or she has applied, is guilty of a Class A misdemeanor and shall, in 16 addition to any other penalty, be fined not less than \$1,000. 17
