Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 2 represented in the General Assembly: 3

- 4 Section 5. The Illinois Roofing Industry Licensing Act is
- 5 amended by changing Section 2 as follows:
- (225 ILCS 335/2) (from Ch. 111, par. 7502) 6
- 7 (Section scheduled to be repealed on January 1, 2016)
- Sec. 2. Definitions. As used in this Act, unless the the 8 context otherwise requires: 9
- (a) "Licensure" means the act of obtaining or holding a 10 license issued by the Department as provided in this Act. 11
- "Department" means the Department of Professional 12 (b) Regulation.
- 14 "Director" means the Director of Professional
- 15 Regulation.

- "Person" 16 means any individual, partnership, 17 corporation, business trust, limited liability company, or
- 18 other legal entity.
- 19 "Roofing contractor" is one whose services are
- knowledge and skill to construct, reconstruct, alter, maintain 21

unlimited in the roofing trade and who has the experience,

- 22 and repair roofs and use materials and items used in the
- 23 construction, reconstruction, alteration, maintenance and
- repair of all kinds of roofing and waterproofing, all in such 24
- 25 manner to comply with all plans, specifications, codes, laws,
- 26 and regulations applicable thereto, but does not include such
- contractor's employees to the extent the requirements of 27
- 28 Section 3 of this Act apply and extend to such employees.
- 29 (f) "Board" means the Roofing Advisory Board.
- 30 (g) "Qualifying party" means the individual filing as a
- sole proprietor, partner of a partnership, officer of 31
- corporation, trustee of a business trust, or party of another 32

- legal entity, who is legally qualified to act for the business
- 2 organization in all matters connected with its roofing
- 3 contracting business, has the authority to supervise roofing
- 4 installation operations, and is actively engaged in day to day
- 5 activities of the business organization.
- 6 "Qualifying party" does not apply to a seller of roofing
- 7 materials or services when the construction, reconstruction,
- 8 alteration, maintenance, or repair of roofing or waterproofing
- 9 is to be performed by a person other than the seller or the
- seller's employees.
- 11 (h) "Limited roofing license" means a license made
- 12 available to contractors whose roofing business is limited to
- 13 residential roofing, including residential properties
- consisting of 8 units or less.
- 15 (i) "Unlimited roofing license" means a license made
- available to contractors whose roofing business is unlimited in
- 17 nature and includes roofing on residential, commercial, and
- industrial properties.
