SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

105 ILCS 126/20

Amends the Childhood Hunger Relief Act. Provides that beginning with the summer of 2007, the board of education of each school district in which at least 50% of the students are eligible for free or reduced-price school meals must operate a summer food service program or identify a non-profit or private agency to sponsor a program (now, by the summer of 2006 and then each summer thereafter, these school districts are strongly encouraged to operate a summer food service program or identify a non-profit or private agency to sponsor a program).

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The Childhood Hunger Relief Act is amended by
- 5 changing Section 20 as follows:

- 7 Sec. 20. Summer food service program.
- 8 (a) The State Board of Education shall promulgate a State
- 9 plan for summer food service programs, in accordance with 42
- 10 U.S.C. Sec. 1761 and any other applicable federal laws and
- 11 regulations, by January 15, 2006.
- 12 (b) Beginning with the summer of 2007, By the summer of
- 13 2006 and then each summer thereafter, it is strongly encouraged
- 14 that the board of education of each school district in this
- 15 State in which at least 50% of the students are eligible for
- free or reduced-price school meals <u>must</u> operate a summer food
- service program or identify a non-profit or private agency to
- 18 sponsor a summer food service program within the school
- 19 district's boundaries.
- 20 (c) Summer food service programs established under this
- 21 Section may be supported by federal funds and commodities and
- other available State and local resources.
