AN ACT making appropriations and reappropriations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

The following named amounts, or so much 4 Section 5. thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects 5 and purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated to the Board 6 7 Trustees of the University of Illinois to meet its of ordinary and contingent expenses for the fiscal year ending 8 9 June 30, 2007: Payable from the General Revenue Fund: 10 11 For Personal Services, including payment to the University for personal services costs 12 incurred during the fiscal year and salaries 13 14 accrued but unpaid to academic personnel for personal services rendered during the 15 2005-2006 academic year\$606,895,000 16 For State Contributions to Social 17 18 19 20 21 22 23 24 25 26 For Distributive Purposes as follows: 27 28 29 For Claims under Workers' Compensation and Occupational Diseases Acts, other 30 31 32 For Current and Prior Year Hospital

Section 10. The sum of \$2,076,600, or so much thereof as 4 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Fire Prevention 5 Fund to the Board of Trustees of the University of Illinois 6 for the purpose of maintaining the Illinois Fire Service 7 Institute, paying the Institute's expenses, and providing the 8 facilities and structures incident thereto, including payment 9 to the University for personal services and related costs 10 11 incurred.

13 Section 15. The sum of \$250,000, or so much thereof as 14 may be necessary, is appropriated from the State College and 15 University Trust Fund to the Board of Trustees of the 16 University of Illinois for scholarship grant awards, in 17 accordance with Public Act 91-83.

19 Section 20. The sum of \$1,000,000, or so much thereof as 20 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue 21 Fund to the University of Illinois for the Complete Help and 22 Assistance Necessary for a College Education (C.H.A.N.C.E) 23 program at the Office of School Relations at the Chicago 24 Campus.

Section 25. The sum of \$3,000,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Board of Trustees of the University of Illinois for the ordinary and contingent expenses for technology transfer.

32 Section 30. The sum of \$6,992,376, or so much thereof as 33 may be necessary and remains unexpended at the close of 34 business on June 30, 2006, from a reappropriation heretofore -3- LRB094 19462 NHT 55255 b

made for such purpose in Article 115, Section 5 of Public Act 1 94-15, is reappropriated from the Capital Development Fund to 2 the Board of Trustees of the University of Illinois for all 3 costs associated with the space needs of the Department of 4 Natural Resources, Illinois Natural History Survey Division 5 6 and State Water Survey Division on the campus of the University of Illinois in Champaign, including construction, 7 capital facilities, planning, relocation, renovation 8 and rehabilitation, mechanical systems, materials, services, and 9 all other costs required to complete the work. 10

Section 35. The sum of \$573,463, or so much thereof as 12 13 may be necessary and remains unexpended on June 30, 2006, from a reappropriation heretofore made for such purpose in 14 115, Section 20 of Public Act 94-0015, 15 Article is reappropriated from the Capital Development Fund to the 16 University of Illinois for digitalization infrastructure for 17 18 WILL-TV (Urbana-Champaign).

Section 40. The sum of \$516,450, or so much thereof as 20 may be necessary and remains unexpended on June 30, 2006, 21 from a reappropriation heretofore made for such purpose in 22 Article 115, Section 30 of Public Act 94-15, 23 is reappropriated from the Capital Development Fund to the 24 University of Illinois at Springfield for constructing a 25 office 26 classroom and building, in addition to funds 27 previously appropriated.

28 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,29 2006.
