33 Whenever it becomes necessary for the State or any

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governmental unit to furnish in a disaster area emergency 1 services directly related to or required by a disaster and 2 existing funds are insufficient to provide such services, the 3 Governor may, when he considers such action in the best 4 interest of the State, release funds from the General Revenue 5 6 disaster relief appropriation in order to provide such services or to reimburse local governmental bodies furnishing 7 such services. Such appropriation may be used for payment of 8 the Illinois National Guard when called to active duty in 9 case of disaster, and for the emergency purchase or renting 10 11 of equipment and commodities. Such appropriation shall be used for emergency services and relief to the disaster area 12 as a whole and shall not be used to provide private relief to 13 persons sustaining property damages or personal injury as a 14 result of a disaster. 15

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1 Section 45. The sum of \$1,166,900, or so much thereof as 2 necessary, is appropriated from the Radiation may be Protection Fund to the Illinois Emergency Management Agency 3 for licensing facilities where radioactive uranium and 4 thorium mill tailings are generated or located, and related 5 costs for regulating the decontamination and decommissioning 6 7 of such facilities and for identification, decontamination and environmental monitoring of unlicensed properties 8 contaminated with such radioactive mill tailings. 9

10 Section 50. The sum of \$561,000, or so much thereof as is appropriated from 11 may be necessary, the Radiation 12 Protection Fund to the Illinois Emergency Management Agency for the purpose of funding costs related to environmental 13 cleanup of the Ottawa Radiation Areas Superfund Project under 14 cooperative agreements with the Federal Government. 15

The sum of \$150,000, or so much thereof as 16 Section 55. is appropriated from 17 may be necessary, the Radiation 18 Protection Fund to the Illinois Emergency Management Agency for recovery and remediation of radioactive materials and 19 contaminated facilities or properties when such expenses 20 cannot be paid by a responsible person or an available 21 22 surety.

The sum of \$100,000, or so much thereof as 23 Section 60. 24 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Nuclear Safety Emergency Preparedness Fund the Illinois Emergency 25 to Management Agency for related training and travel expenses 26 and to reimburse the Illinois State Police and the Illinois 27 28 Commerce Commission for costs incurred for activities related 29 to inspecting and escorting shipments of spent nuclear fuel, high-level radioactive waste, and transuranic waste 30 in 31 Illinois as provided under the rules of the Agency.

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1 Section 65. The sum of \$180,000, or so much thereof as 2 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Sheffield Agreed 3 Order Fund to the Illinois Emergency Management Agency for 4 the care, maintenance, monitoring, testing, remediation and 5 insurance of the low-level radioactive waste disposal site 6 near Sheffield, Illinois.

7 Section 70. The sum of \$686,600, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Low-Level 8 Radioactive Waste Facility Development and Operation Fund to 9 Illinois Emergency Management Agency for use 10 the in accordance with Section 14(a) of the Illinois Low-Level 11 Radioactive Waste Management Act for costs related to 12 establishing a low-level radioactive waste disposal facility. 13

Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1, 2006.

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
