A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**  
3 **in the General Assembly:**

5 Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much of  
6 those amounts as may be necessary, respectively, for the  
7 objects and purposes named, are appropriated from the General  
8 Revenue Fund to meet the ordinary and contingent expenses of  
9 the Office of the State Appellate Defender.

10 Section 15. The following named amounts, or so much of  
 11 those amounts as may be necessary, respectively, for the  
 12 objects and purposes named, are appropriated to the office  
 13 of the State Appellate Defender for expenses related to  
 14 federally assisted programs to work on systemic sentencing  
 15 issues appeals cases to which the agency is appointed.

21 Section 20. The sum of \$3,218,041, or so much thereof as  
 22 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Capital Litigation  
 23 Trust Fund to the Office of the State Appellate Defender for  
 24 expenses incurred in providing assistance to trial attorneys  
 25 under item (c)(5) of Section 10 of the State Appellate  
 26 Defender Act.

27

28 Section 25. The sum of \$250,000, or so much thereof as may  
 29 be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund  
 30 to the Office of the State Appellate Defender for the  
 31 ordinary and contingent expenses of the Expungement Program.

33 Section 30. The sum of \$53,100, or so much thereof as may  
 34 be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund

1 to the Office of the State Appellate Defender to provide  
2 statewide training to Public Defenders under the Public  
3 Defender Training Program.

5 Section 35. The sum of \$200,000, or so much thereof as may  
6 be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund  
7 to the Office of the State Appellate Defender to enhance the  
8 capability of public defenders in rural counties to  
9 effectively represent their clients in appropriate cases,  
10 making available to them expert witnesses and investigative  
11 services under the Rural Public Defender Services Program.

12 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,  
13 2006.
