1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 1. The following named amounts, or so much
5 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects
6 and purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated to the
7 Office of the State Comptroller for the fiscal year ending
8 June 30, 2007:

9 For Personal Services:

10 Official Court Reporting36,837,900

11 For Employee Retirement Contributions

12 Paid by the Employer1,473,500

13 For State Contributions to the State

14 Employees' Retirement System4,246,900

15 For State Contributions to Social

16 Security2,819,000

17 For Travel:

18 For Official Court Reporting167,900

19 For Contractual Services4,046,700

20 For Commodities1,000

21 For Printing0

22 For Equipment5,000

25 Section 2. The amount of \$750,000, or so much thereof as
26 may be necessary, is appropriated to the State Comptroller
27 for ordinary and contingent expenses associated with the
28 payment to official court reporters pursuant to law.

29 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
