2 WHEREAS, Healthy people and healthy communities are the 3 centerpiece of any strong and vibrant society; and

- WHEREAS, Americans from the State of Illinois are amongst the most generous people in the world; and
- 6 WHEREAS, ONE billion people live on less than \$1 a day; and
- WHEREAS, ONE: The Campaign to Make Poverty History is a new effort by Americans to rally Americans ONE by ONE to fight the emergency of global AIDS and extreme poverty; and
- 10 WHEREAS, ONE is students and ministers, punk rockers and
 11 NASCAR moms, Americans of all beliefs and persuasions, united
 12 as ONE to help make poverty history; and
- 13 WHEREAS, ONE believes that allocating an additional ONE
 14 percent of the U.S. budget toward providing basic needs like
 15 health, education, clean water, and food would transform the
 16 futures and hopes of an entire generation in the world's
 17 poorest countries; and
- 18 WHEREAS, ONE also calls for debt cancellation, trade 19 reform, and anti-corruption measures in a comprehensive 20 package to help Africa and the poorest nations beat AIDS and 21 extreme poverty; and
- 22 WHEREAS, A pact directing support for basic needs 23 education, health, clean water, food, and care for orphans 24 would transform the futures and hopes of an entire generation
 25 in the poorest countries; and
- 26 WHEREAS, ONE is an unprecedented bipartisan political 27 movement in American history and part of a fast-growing global
