HOUSE RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, In the past couple of weeks, the Iraqi people were 2 3 able to participate in a free election for the first time in 504 years and showed the world that they supported democracy with a 5 greater-than 60% voter turnout in that country ruled by a brutal dictator only two years ago; and 6 7 WHEREAS, It was a stated objective of Operation Iraqi 8 Freedom to liberate the people of Iraq from a violent, 9 oppressive regime that supported terrorism in other countries 10 and that took pleasure in the events of September 11, 2001; and WHEREAS, On Sunday, January 30, 2005, an historic election 11 took place in Iraq - and around the world - to elect a 12 13 275-member Transitional National Assembly which will draft Iraq's new constitution to be presented to the Iraqi people for 14 their approval in a national referendum in October of 2005; and 15 WHEREAS, A voter-registration list of 14.3 million names 16 was compiled in six weeks and more than 500 voter registration 17 centers were established to help Iraqis verify their 18 19 registration, on election day, Iraqis and voted at. approximately 5,200 voting centers across Iraq; and 20 21 WHEREAS, International support for the Iraqi election has 22 been essential using military forces from 28 nations working 23 alongside Iraqi forces to help establish stability and security 24 throughout Iraq; and 25 WHEREAS, We recognize the Illinois men and women who paid

those who have come home with injuries sustained in the War on Terrorism on the battlefields of Iraq and Afghanistan; and

- 6 NINETY-FOURTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that
- 7 we congratulate the Iraqi people on conducting a successful
- 8 election and extend our best wishes in their efforts to
- 9 establish a Democratic government; and be it further
- 10 RESOLVED, During this time after the Iraqi national
- 11 election, the members of the House of Representatives want to
- once again thank the Illinois men and women who make up our
- 13 National Guard and Reserve units and who are members of the
- regular military for their service in Iraq; and be it further
- 15 RESOLVED, That suitable copies of this resolution shall be
- delivered to President George W. Bush and to the members of the
- 17 Illinois Congressional Delegation.
