WHEREAS, Illinois was listed on the "Fatal Fifteen" list
compiled by the national physicians group End Needless Death on
Our Roadways; and

7 WHEREAS, Additional attention should be given to the problem of8 drunk driving and related issues; therefore, be it

9 RESOLVED, BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 10 NINETY-FOURTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that a 11 task force be established to recommend steps that the State 12 might take to reduce drunk driving; and be it further

task force 13 RESOLVED, That the shall include: one 14 legislative member and one private citizen member appointed by 15 each of the following: the Speaker and Minority Leader of the 16 House of Representatives; one private citizen appointed by the Governor; and one member appointed by each of the following: 17 18 the Department of Transportation; the Department of State Illinois Emergency Management Agency; 19 Police; the the Department of Public Health; the Department of Corrections; 20 21 Mothers Against Drunk Driving; the Fraternal Order of Police; 22 the Illinois Sheriffs Association; and the Illinois 23 Firefighters Association; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the task force shall file a report of its findings and recommendations with the House of Representatives and the Governor by January 1, 2007; and be it further
