10 RESOLVED, BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE

11 NINETY-FOURTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that

there is hereby created a Visitation Task Force that shall

study the frequency of and problems caused by the denial of

court-ordered visitation to a parent and the possible solutions

to this problem; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the Task Force shall consist of 6 members,

with 3 members appointed by the Speaker of the House of

Representatives and 3 members appointed by the Minority Leader

of the House of Representatives; and be it further

20 RESOLVED, That the Task Force shall present a report of its

21 findings and recommendations to the General Assembly no later

22 than October 1, 2005.
