HOUSE RESOLUTION

2 WHEREAS, The members of the House of Representatives of the 3 State of Illinois take great pride in and express gratitude to 4 those citizens who assume great personal risk to protect the 5 lives and well-being of other citizens; and

WHEREAS, On December 24, 2004, Deputy Jason Brown came upon a traffic accident while on his way home to Blue Mound; a sport utility vehicle had left the highway and hit an embankment, killing one passenger and leaving another trapped inside; and

WHEREAS, As fire flared in the engine compartment, Deputy Brown and another passenger pulled John Gehrken of Decatur from the rear seat through a broken window; moments later, the entire vehicle was engulfed in flames; and

WHEREAS, For his heroic efforts on the scene, he was selected as one of 13 recipients of the Law Enforcement Medal of Honor; the medal is bestowed on officers who have "distinguished themselves by gallantry and intrepidity at the risk of their lives above and beyond the call of duty"; and

WHEREAS, Deputy Brown has worked at the Macon County Sheriff's Office for several years; he was one of several officers laid off when the county came on hard times, paid his own way through the Illinois State Police Academy, and was hired as soon as he graduated; he is known for his keen investigation skills and his sense for finding people; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE NINETY-FOURTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that we commend and applaud Deputy Jason Brown for his brave service to Macon County, and we congratulate him on being a recipient of the Law Enforcement Medal of Honor; and be it further
