Claude Howell of the Odin Fire 17 Protection District, and Chief Roger Mann and firefighter Randy 18 Schreffler of the Salem Fire Protection District; and 19 20 WHEREAS, The volunteers who deployed to Hammond, 21 Louisiana, were Officer Bryan Green of Salem Police Department and Officer Rob Dillon of Centralia Police Department; and 22 23 WHEREAS, Many volunteers are still working to satisfy their 24 mission; therefore, be it
