WHEREAS, Chief Barthelemy has served on the Board of Directors of the Decatur Boys & Girls Club for 18 years, including a 3-year term as President of the Board; he also serves on the boards of the Decatur Community Partnership, Webster-Cantrell Hall, the Decatur Area Convention and Visitors Bureau, and is a member of the International and Illinois Association of Chiefs of Police; he continues to be involved in numerous civic activities relating to Police-Community Relations; and

WHEREAS, He is also recognized as the Decatur Police Department's official historian, having initiated his research

- in 1995; currently, he has written the department's history
