1 HOUSE RESOLUTION WHEREAS, Indigency has been a persistent social problem 2 throughout history and has reached an intolerable level 3 4 throughout our country; and WHEREAS, People in urban, suburban, and rural areas of 5 Illinois experience indigency, proving that it is not just a 6 7 big city problem; and 8 WHEREAS, Each year sees an increase in the number of deaths 9 among those who lack funds to provide the barest essentials of life; and 10 11 WHEREAS, Bitter cold winters and extremely hot summers have 12 cost the lives of those individuals who simply could not afford 13 heating or air coolants and died from exposure; and 14 WHEREAS, In remembering those who have died, we must reach 15 out to help those in need; the extent to which our society can counter the effects of indigency is a good measure of its 16 humaneness; therefore, be it 17 18 HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF RESOLVED, ΒY THE THE NINETY-FOURTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that 19 we proclaim Wednesday, May 24, 2006, as "We Remember, We Care 20 21 for Indigent Persons Day in Illinois", and that we urge all 22 citizens to observe, inform themselves of, and support efforts to care for the indigent; and be it further 23 RESOLVED, That a suitable copy of this resolution be 24 25 presented to Fr. Larry Janezic, OFM, Director of the Memorial Ministry of Indigent Persons. 26
