## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Pension Code is amended by changing Section 7-219 as follows:
- 6 (40 ILCS 5/7-219) (from Ch. 108 1/2, par. 7-219)
- 7 Sec. 7-219. Felony conviction.
- None of the benefits provided for in this Article shall be paid to any person who is convicted of any felony relating to or arising out of or in connection with his service as an employee. If the person convicted of such a felony is an employee of more than one employer that participates in the Fund, then the person may not receive benefits based on any of his or her service as an employee for all employers that
- participate in the Fund.
- This Section shall not operate to impair any contract or 16 17 vested right heretofore acquired under any law or laws continued in this Article, nor to preclude the right to a 18 19 refund; except that, notwithstanding Section 7-217 and the other provisions of this Code, if, as a result of the felony, 20 the person is ordered by the court to pay restitution to the 21 employer, then (i) the employer may apply for a refund of 22 employee contributions on the employee's behalf and (ii) 23 pursuant to appropriate documentation from the employer and the 24 25 court, the Fund shall pay to the employer all or a portion of 26 the refund in a sum sufficient to satisfy the court-ordered
