Amend Senate Bill 951, AS AMENDED, 3 with reference to page and line numbers of Senate Amendment No. 1, on page 5, between lines 15 and 16, by inserting the 4 following: 5 "(A-10) The Illinois Department may deny, suspend, or 6 7 terminate the eligibility of any person, firm, corporation, association, agency, institution, or other legal entity to participate as a vendor of goods or services to recipients under the medical assistance program under Article V if, after 10 reasonable notice and opportunity for a hearing, the Illinois 11 Department finds that (i) the vendor, (ii) a person with 12 management responsibility for a vendor, (iii) an officer or 13 person owning, either directly or indirectly, 5% or more of the 14 shares of stock or other evidences of ownership in a corporate 15 vendor, (iv) an owner of a sole proprietorship that is a 16 17 vendor, or (v) a partner in a partnership that is a vendor has 18 been convicted of a felony offense related to any of the following: 19 20 (1) Murder. 21 (2) A Class X felony under the Criminal Code of 1961.".
