AN ACT concerning appropriations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

4	Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much
5	thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects
6	and purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated from the
7	General Revenue Fund to the Board of the Trustees of the
8	University of Illinois to meet ordinary and contingent
9	expenses for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2006:

Section 10. The sum of \$1,998,500, or so much thereof as 4 5 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Fire Prevention Fund to the Board of Trustees of the University of Illinois 6 for the purpose of maintaining the Illinois Fire Service 7 Institute, paying the Institute's expenses, and providing the 8 facilities and structures incident thereto, including payment 9 10 to the University for personal services and related costs incurred. 11

Section 15. The sum of \$250,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the State College and University Trust Fund to the Board of Trustees of the University of Illinois for scholarship grant awards, in accordance with Public Act 91-83.

Section 20. The sum of \$3,000,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Board of Trustees of the University of Illinois for the ordinary and contingent expenses for technology transfer.

22 Section 25. The sum of \$10,374,575, or so much thereof as 23 may be necessary and remains unexpended at the close of business on June 30, 2005, from a reappropriation heretofore 24 made for that purpose in Article 110, Section 10 of Public 25 Act 93-842 is reappropriated from the Capital Development 26 27 Fund to the Board of Trustees of the University of Illinois for all costs associated with the space needs of 28 the Department of Natural Resources, Illinois Natural History 29 30 Survey Division and State Water Survey Division on the campus - 3 -

1 of the University of Illinois in Champaign, including 2 construction, capital facilities, planning, relocation, 3 renovation and rehabilitation, mechanical systems, materials, 4 services and all other costs required to complete the work.

Section 30. The sum of \$3,770,922, or so much thereof as 5 may be necessary and remains unexpended at the close of 6 7 business on June 30, 2005, from a reappropriation heretofore made for that purpose in Article 110, Section 15 of Public 8 Act 93-842, is reappropriated from the Capital Development 9 10 Fund to the Board of Trustees of the University of Illinois to plan and construct an Education and Research facility for 11 12 the College of Medicine in Chicago, including planning, land 13 acquisition, demolition, construction, remodeling, landscaping, site improvements, equipment, extension 14 or 15 modification of campus utility systems, relocation of programs, and such expenses as may be necessary to complete 16 17 the facility. This appropriation is in addition to any other funds appropriated for this purpose for this fiscal year. 18

Section 35. The sum of \$147,294, or so much thereof as 19 may be necessary and remains unexpended at the close of 20 business on June 30, 2005, from a reappropriation heretofore 21 made for such purpose in Article 110, Section 25 of Public 22 Act 93-842, is reappropriated from the Capital Development 23 for digitalization 24 Fund to the University of Illinois 25 infrastructure for WILL-TV (Urbana-Champaign).

Section 40. The sum of \$814,444, or so much thereof as may be necessary and remains unexpended at the close of business on June 30, 2005, from a reappropriation heretofore made for such purpose in Article 110, Section 30 of Public Act 93-842, is reappropriated from the Capital Development Fund to the University of Illinois for digitalization -4- LRB094 09471 RAS 39722 b

1 infrastructure for WILL-TV (Urbana-Champaign).

Section 45. The sum of \$94,568, or so much thereof as may 2 be necessary and remains unexpended at the close of business 3 on June 30, 2005, from a reappropriation heretofore made for 4 that purpose in Article 110, Section 35 of Public Act 93-842, 5 is reappropriated from the Capital Development Fund to the 6 Board of Trustees of the University of Illinois to plan and 7 construct a Classroom and Office Building at the Springfield 8 Campus and related utility systems, including planning, land 9 10 acquisition, demolition, construction, remodeling, landscaping, site improvements, equipment, extension or 11 12 modification of campus utility systems, and such expenses as may be necessary to complete the facility. This appropriation 13 is in addition to any other funds appropriated for this 14 purpose for this fiscal year. 15

16 Section 50. The sum of \$2,757,074, or so much thereof as may be necessary and remains unexpended at the close of 17 business on June 30, 2005, from a reappropriation heretofore 18 made for such purpose in Article 110, Section 45 of Public 19 Act 93-842, is reappropriated from the Capital Development 20 Fund to the University of Illinois at Springfield for 21 constructing a classroom and office building, in addition to 22 funds previously appropriated. 23

Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,25 2005.
