AN ACT concerning State government.

## 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The State Treasurer Act is amended by changing
Section 18 as follows:

Sec. 18. Banking and automatic teller machine services.

8 (a) The Treasurer may enter into written agreements with financial institutions for the provision of banking services at 9 the State Capitol and for the provision of automatic teller 10 machine services at State office buildings, State parks, and 11 State tourism centers, and State fairs at Springfield and 12 DuQuoin. The Treasurer shall establish competitive procedures 13 14 for the selection of financial institutions to provide the 15 services authorized under this Section. No State agency may procure services authorized by this Section without the 16 17 approval of the Treasurer.

(b) The Treasurer shall enter into written agreements with 18 19 the authorities having jurisdiction of the property where the services are intended to be provided. These agreements shall 20 include, but need not be limited to, the quantity of machines 21 22 to be located at the property and the exact location of the 23 service or machine and shall establish responsibility for payment of expenses incurred in locating the machine or 24 25 service.

(c) The Treasurer's agreement with a financial institution
may authorize the financial institution to provide any or all
of the banking services that the financial institution is
otherwise authorized by law to provide to the public.

30 The Treasurer's agreement with a financial institution 31 shall establish the amount of compensation to be paid by the 32 financial institution. The financial institution shall pay the SB1661 Engrossed - 2 - LRB094 11260 RSP 42025 b

1 compensation to the Treasurer in accordance with the terms of 2 the agreement. The Treasurer shall deposit moneys received 3 under this Section into the Treasurer's Rental Fee Fund, a 4 special fund hereby created in the State treasury. The 5 Treasurer shall use the moneys in the Fund for the operation of 6 the program established under this Section.

7 (d) This Section does not apply to a State office building 8 in which a currency exchange or a credit union providing 9 financial services located in the building on July 1, 1995 (the 10 effective date of Public Act 88-640) is operating.
