| 10 | this employment meets the requirements of the permit |
| 11 | program. This information shall include a copy of the |
| 12 | written employment offer and a statement signed by a |
| 13 | registered nurse licensed under this Act who has agreed to |
| 14 | directly supervise the applicant. |
| 15 | (5) Has submitted a written statement from the |
| 16 | applicant's prospective employer stating that the |
| 17 | prospective employer agrees to pay the full tuition for the |
| 18 | Bilingual Nurse Consortium course or other course approved |
| 19 | by rule. |

| 21 | applicant's prospective employer stating that the |

| 4 | (c) A nurse intern shall be issued no more then one permit |
| 5 | in a lifetime. The permit shall expire one calendar year after |
| 6 | it is issued. Before the expiration of the permit, the nurse |
| 7 | intern must submit proof of the successful completion of the |
| 8 | Bilingual Nurse Consortium course or other course approved by |
| 9 | rule and the successful passage of a test of competency in the |
| 10 | English language which shall be prescribed by the Department. |
| 11 | The nurse intern shall not practice professional nursing except |
| 12 | under the direct supervision of a registered nurse licensed |
| 13 | under this Act and shall not be employed in a supervisory |
| 14 | capacity. The nurse intern shall work only in the sponsoring |
| 15 | facility. A nurse intern may work for a period not to exceed |
| 16 | one calendar year from the date of issuance of the permit or |
| 17 | until he or she fails the NCLEX. While working as a nurse |
| 18 | intern, the nurse intern is subject to the provisions of this |
| 19 | Act and all rules adopted by the Department for the |
| 20 | administration of this Act. |
