#### SB1986

Introduced 2/25/2005, by Sen. Steven J. Rauschenberger

#### SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

305 ILCS 5/12-4.201

Amends the Illinois Public Aid Code. In provisions concerning the Department of Public Aid's data warehouse concerning medical and related services, provides that the Department shall perform all necessary administrative functions to expand its linearly-scalable data warehouse to encompass other healthcare data sources at both the Department of Human Services and the Department of Public Health. Provides that the Department shall leverage the inherent capabilities of the data warehouse to accomplish this expansion with marginal additional technical administration. Provides that the purpose of this expansion is to allow for programmatic review and analysis including the interrelatedness among the various healthcare programs in order to ascertain effectiveness toward, and ultimate impact on, clients. Provides that beginning July 1, 2005, the Department shall supply quarterly reports to the Commission on Government Forecasting and Accountability detailing progress toward this mandate. Effective immediately.

# 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Illinois Public Aid Code is amended by 5 changing Section 12-4.201 as follows:

6 (305 ILCS 5/12-4.201)

7 Sec. 12-4.201.

8 (a) Data warehouse concerning medical and related services. The Illinois Department of Public Aid may purchase 9 services and materials associated with the costs of developing 10 and implementing a data warehouse comprised of management and 11 decision making information in regard to the liability 12 associated with, and utilization of, medical and related 13 14 services, out of moneys available for that purpose.

15 (b) The Department of Public Aid shall perform all necessary administrative functions to expand 16 its 17 linearly-scalable data warehouse to encompass other healthcare data sources at both the Department of Human Services and the 18 19 Department of Public Health. The Department of Public Aid shall 20 leverage the inherent capabilities of the data warehouse to 21 accomplish this expansion with marginal additional technical administration. The purpose of this expansion is to allow for 22 23 programmatic review and analysis including the interrelatedness among the various healthcare programs in 24 25 order to ascertain effectiveness toward, and ultimate impact on, clients. Beginning July 1, 2005, the Department of Public 26 Aid shall supply quarterly reports to the Commission on 27 28 Government Forecasting and Accountability detailing progress toward this mandate. 29
