Amend Senate Bill 2277, AS AMENDED, 3 by replacing everything after the enacting clause with the 4 following: 5 "Section 5. The Illinois Horse Racing Act of 1975 is 6 amended by changing Section 28.1 as follows: 7 (230 ILCS 5/28.1) 8 Sec. 28.1. Payments. (a) Beginning on January 1, 2000, moneys collected by the 9 Department of Revenue and the Racing Board pursuant to Section 10 26 or Section 27 of this Act shall be deposited into the Horse 11 12

- Racing Fund, which is hereby created as a special fund in the State Treasury.
- (b) Appropriations, as approved by the General Assembly, 14 15 may be made from the Horse Racing Fund to the Board to pay the salaries of the Board members, secretary, stewards, directors 16 mutuels, veterinarians, representatives, accountants, 17 18 clerks, stenographers, inspectors and other employees of the Board, and all expenses of the Board incident to 19 administration of this Act, including, but not limited to, all 20 21 expenses and salaries incident to the taking of saliva and urine samples in accordance with the rules and regulations of 22 23 the Board.
- (c) Beginning on January 1, 2000, the Board shall transfer 24

the remainder of the funds generated pursuant to Sections 26 1 and 27 from the Horse Racing Fund into the General Revenue

(d) Beginning January 1, 2000, payments to all programs in 4 5 existence on the effective date of this amendatory Act of 1999 that are identified in Sections 26(c), 26(f), 26(h) (11) (C), and 6 28, subsections (a), (b), (c), (d), (e), (f), (g), and (h) of 7 8 Section 30, and subsections (a), (b), (c), (d), (e), (f), (g), and (h) of Section 31 shall be made from the General Revenue 9 Fund at the funding levels determined by amounts paid under 10 this Act in calendar year 1998. Beginning on the effective date 11 of this amendatory Act of the 93rd General Assembly, payments 12 to the Peoria Park District shall be made from the General 13 Revenue Fund at the funding level determined by amounts paid to 14 15 that park district for museum purposes under this Act in calendar year 1994. Beginning on the effective date of this 16 amendatory Act of the 94th General Assembly, payments to the 17 Urbana Park District shall be made from the General Revenue 18 Fund at the funding level determined by amounts paid to the 19 20 Champaign Park District for museum purposes under this Act in 21 calendar year 2005.

(e) Beginning July 1, 2006, the payment authorized under subsection (d) to museums and aquariums located in park districts of over 500,000 population shall be paid to museums, aquariums, and zoos in amounts determined by Museums in the Park, an association of museums, aquariums, and zoos located on Chicago Park District property.
