1 AN ACT concerning alcoholic liquor.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Liquor Control Act of 1934 is amended by adding Section 6-33 as follows:
- 6 (235 ILCS 5/6-33 new)
- 7 Sec. 6-33. Alcohol without liquid machines.
- 8 (a) No person shall bring into this State for use or sale
- 9 <u>any alcohol without liquid machine.</u>
- 10 (b) For the purposes of this Section, "alcohol without
- liquid machine" means a device designed or marketed for the
- 12 purposes of mixing alcohol with oxygen or another gas to
- produce a mist for inhalation for recreational purposes.
- 14 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- 15 becoming law.
