SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

Appropriates \$8,500,000 from the General Revenue Fund as follows: (1) \$6,000,000 to the Early Intervention Services Revolving Fund for a 5% cost-of-doing-business increase for 16 specified early intervention services at the Department of Human Services for payment for early intervention services; and (2) \$2,500,000 to the Department of Healthcare and Family Services, for a 5% cost-of-doing-business increase for providers of each of the following services in connection with the provision of therapy services: physical therapy, speech therapy, and occupational therapy funded by the Department of Healthcare and Family Services. Effective July 1, 2006.

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. In addition to any other amounts heretofore
5 appropriated for these purposes, the sum of \$8,500,000, or so
6 much of that amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from
7 the General Revenue Fund as follows:

8 (1) \$6,000,000 to the Early Intervention Services
9 Revolving Fund for a 5% cost-of-doing-business increase for
10 the 16 early intervention services, including assistive
11 technology, audiology, clinical assessment, counseling, and
12 other therapeutic services, developmental therapy, family
13 training and support, health consultation, medical services,
14 nursing services, nutrition services, occupational therapy,
15 physical therapy, service coordination, social services,
16 speech language services, transportation, and vision
17 services, at the Department of Human Services for payment for
18 early intervention services.

19 (2) \$2,500,000 to the Department of Healthcare and Family
20 Services, for a 5% cost-of-doing-business increase for
21 providers of each of the following services in connection
22 with the provision of therapy services: physical therapy,
23 speech therapy, and occupational therapy funded by the
24 Department of Healthcare and Family Services.

25 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
26 2006.
