

## 94TH GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2005 and 2006 SB2518

## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

30 ILCS 105/25.5 new

Amends the State Finance Act. Requires that each July 31 the Governor must report to the General Assembly and the public upon the fiscal impact of all executive orders issued or signed during the previous fiscal year. Specifies the items that must be included for each executive order to reflect the cost of implementing, administering, and enforcing the order and the percentage of those costs borne by current and future appropriations. Effective immediately.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The State Finance Act is amended by adding
- 5 Section 25.5 as follows:
- 6 (30 ILCS 105/25.5 new)
- 7 Sec. 25.5. Executive orders. On July 31 of each year the Governor shall submit to the General Assembly and make 8 available to the public a report of the fiscal impact of all 9 executive orders issued or signed by the Governor during the 10 immediately previous fiscal year. For each executive order, the 11 report shall specify (i) the dollar amount of funds expended or 12 obligated to implement, administer, and enforce the executive 13 order, (ii) the dollar amount of funds anticipated to be 14 15 expended or obligated to implement, administer, and enforce the executive order, and (iii) the percentages of the amounts 16 listed in items (i) and (ii) that derive or are anticipated to 17 derive from funds appropriated for the fiscal year in which the 18 19 executive order was issued or signed, funds appropriated for the fiscal year immediately after the executive order was 20
